Did you know you only have 52 chances a year to celebrate with your best friends at All Saints?

Yikes, you should sign up immediately...

Pick your Sunday now so you don't miss your chance!!!

Providing 10:30 am Hospitality is Easy and Fun!!!

1. Plan for about 75 people (big and little)
2. Choose a sweet (always first because sweets are the best!)
3. Choose a savory (yummy too! Cheese and crackers, vegetable tray, cocktail meatballs, little quiches)
4. Choose a juice (Just one half gallon is fine)
5. Coffee, tea and cocoa supplies are in the kitchen along with the coffee pots for brewing. (Except for the cream for the coffee and tea... a half pint is enough!)
6. Cups, plates, bowls, napkins, plastic forks, spoon and knives are (usually) in the kitchen.

Getting to church a little early is helpful so you can actually attend the service!

1. A long table usually is set up in the Parish Hall.
2. Table clothes are in the marked cabinets in the kitchen.
3. Just put a table cloth on the table.
4. Put out plates, bowls napkins ... whatever your hospitality requires.
5. Put the sweets and savories on platters if necessary. (It is good to keep them in the kitchen during the service. Platters are in the dish washing section in the little room along with other serving options)
6. Set up the coffee pots for brewing and just check the hot water pot from the 8:00 am service to make sure there is enough hot water!
7. After communion race to the kitchen and put out all of your offerings!
8. There are, very often, wonderful helpers available in the Parish Hall! Just ask them for help because they love to help!
7. ... and you can always, always, always ask your *Humble Diva* for help because she really appreciates you providing hospitality for everyone!
