

MAUNDY THURSDAY

Maundy Thursday is an opportunity for both a service and fellowship through a dinner following the service.

The service was planned by the Worship Committee and clergy – there was an opportunity for foot washing in the service. [I have no further info]

Promotion: invitation to the service and dinner should be placed in enotes, the CAS for Lent and announcements starting in mid Lent or at least 2 Sundays before Maundy Thursday. Be sure to note that it is a dinner [see below] and the time for the service

Themes – In 2006 we did a soup supper – about 35 people came – we had about 6 soups provided and Laura arranged for bread, wine from the church stores, water on the table in carafes and several people brought salads – need about 4 -6 salads.

Another theme in the past has been a potluck buffet with Bible foods – olives, pita bread, dolmas, hummus and baba ganoush, tabouli, etc.

Setup – in 2006 Laura Biche did the set up – the tables were placed in one long line with white table clothes and candles and some greens – it was beautiful but I don't remember exactly what Laura used for the table decorations. The parish hall lighting was kept low (only the column lights) to work well with the candle light and provide a quiet atmosphere.

Also there was a table for the soups set up near the kitchen
